Creating the Layout

1. Cut 3 different pieces of patterned paper at 3 x 4-1/2 inches.
2. Stack the 3 pieces together and place them in your paper trimmer with the 3-inch side at the top of the trimmer. You will be cutting all 3 pieces at the same time.
3. Cut a 3/4 x 4-1/2 inch piece, then cut a 1 x 4-1/2 inch piece.
4. You will end up with three pieces measuring: 3/4 x 4-1/2, 1 x 4-1/2 and 1-1/4 x 4-1/2 inches.
5. Shuffle the pieces around to create 3 panel style layouts. Each layout will have all three pattern papers but in different sizes.
6. Arrange three different patterned papers measuring 3/4 x 4-1/2, 1 x 4-1/2 and 1-1/4 x 4-1/2 inches across a 3-1/2 x 4-3/4 inch piece of white cardstock. Adhere the white cardstock to a card base.

Floral Delight Cards



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Old Olive cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
2. Create the layouts using 3 different pieces of the Floral Delight Designer Series Paper and adhere to the Old Olive card base.
3. Die cut the "wishing" greeting from a piece of white and Old Olive cardstock. Adhere the two die cut shapes together and then adhere to the card front. Create the same greeting for all 3 cards.
4. Stamp the second part of the greeting on a scrap piece of white cardstock using Old Olive ink. Cut out the greeting with the coordinating label die and adhere to the card front. Create the same second greeting for all 3 cards.
5. Embellish a tiny bee trinket.

Darling Dinos Cards



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Crumb Cake cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
2. Create the layouts using 3 different pieces of the Timeless Plaid Designer Series Paper and adhere to the Crumb Cake card base.
3. Cut out three rectangular shapes from a piece of white cardstock using the Nested Essentials Dies.
4. Stamp the dinosaur image on the 3 rectangular shapes using Early Espresso ink. Color in the dinosaur with the light and dark shades of the Crumb Cake Stampin' Blend. Adhere to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.
5. Stamp the balloon image on a scrap piece of Crumb Cake cardstock three times using Early Espresso ink. Cut out the balloons with the coordinating Darling Dinos dies.
6. Stamp the balloon image on a scrap piece of Lost Lagoon cardstock three times using Early Espresso ink. Cut out the balloons with the coordinating Darling Dinos dies.
7. Stamp the balloon strings on the left side of card front, directly on the patterned paper, using Early Espresso ink. Adhere a balloon to the top of each string with a stampin' dimensional.
8. Stamp a greeting, three times, on a 3/4 x 2 inch piece of white cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.

Wildflower Birthday Cards



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Soft Sea Foam cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
2. Create the layouts using 3 different pieces of the Wildflower Birthday Designer Series Paper and adhere to the Soft Sea Foam card base.
3. Cut out three banner shapes from a piece of white cardstock using the Nested Essentials Dies.
4. Stamp a greeting on each of the banners using Pretty In Pink and/or Peach Pie. Adhere the banner to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.
5. Embellish with some antique pearls and some of the die cut flowers from the Wildflower Birthday DSP pack.
