

# Easy Inside Pop-Up Card



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This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.

The supplies used to create these cards are available, while supplies last, through my Stampin' Up! store at <https://lynneddunn.stampinup.net> so feel free to shop online for supplies or use some of your own materials that you may have on hand.

*Stamp Set and Punch*

### **Pop Up Card**



1. Start with a 4-1/4 x 11 inch piece of Melon Mambo cardstock. Score the 11 inch side at 5-1/2 inches to create the base of the card.
2. Cut a 3-3/4 x 5 inch piece of white cardstock and adhere to the card front.
3. Cut a 2-1/2 x 4-3/4 inch piece of the green patterned paper and adhere to the white cardstock as shown.
4. Cut a 3-3/4 x 1 inch piece of the striped patterned paper and adhere to the bottom of the white cardstock as shown.
5. Stamp the large toadstool image using Melon Mambo ink. Stamp the stem using Gray Granite ink. Use the Toadstool punch and/or a pair of scissors to cut out the images. Adhere the pieces together with liquid glue.

6. Stamp the smaller toadstool image using Peach Pie ink. Stamp the stem using Basic Beige ink. Use the Toadstool punch and/or a pair of scissors to cut out the images. Adhere the pieces together with liquid glue.
7. Stamp the ground image using Crumb Cake ink. Cut out the image with a scissors and adhere the toadstool images behind it as shown. Add stampin' dimensionals and adhere to the card front.
8. Stamp a greeting on a 1/2 inch wide scrap piece of white cardstock using Gray Granite ink. Trim down the greeting with a scissors and adhere to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.
9. Embellish with a few adhesive-backed textured dots.

### Creating the Inside Pop Up Section

10. Cut a 3-3/4 x 10-1/2 inch piece of white cardstock.
11. Score the white cardstock at 4-1/4, 5-1/4 and 6-1/4 inches. Accordion fold the cardstock to create the look of a step in the center of the white cardstock.
12. Cut a 3-1/2 x 4 inch piece of green patterned paper and adhere to the top section of the white cardstock.
13. Cut two pieces of the green patterned paper at 3/4 x 3-1/2 inches and adhere one to each of the "step" sections on the white cardstock.
14. Stamp a greeting on the bottom section of the white cardstock using Gray Granite ink.



15. Fold the white cardstock in half. Add adhesive to the back side of the white cardstock (which has the greeting) and adhere to the bottom of the inside of the card. Accordion fold everything down on top of the greeting and add adhesive to the back side of the top of the white cardstock (which has the patterned paper). Close the card on top of the white cardstock to adhere the pop up section.

16. Create another set of the toadstools by following Step #5-7. Adhere the toadstools to the bottom part of the pop up section on the inside of the card using liquid glue.
