

Easy Patterned Paper Pop-Up Card



This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.

Pop Up Card



1. Start with a 4-1/4 x 5-1/2 inch piece of Basic Black cardstock to create the base of the card.

2. Cut a 5-1/4 x 12 inch piece of patterned paper. Score the 12 inch side at 1, 4, 6, and 8 inches.

Accordion fold the patterned paper and adhere the 4 x 5-1/4 inch section to the Basic Black cardstock.

3. Cut a 2-1/2 inch circle shape from a piece of white cardstock using the Stylish Shapes Dies.

4. Stamp a greeting on the white circle shape using Early Espresso ink. Adhere the circle shape to the 1 inch flap on the front of the card.

5. Cut out a small floral image from a piece of the Lovely Garden Designer Series Paper using a scissors. Adhere to the top part of the greeting, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.

6. Embellish the greeting with an iridescent foil gem.

7. Cut out a larger floral image from a piece of the Lovely Garden Designer Series Paper using a scissors. Adhere to the pop up section on the inside of the card, as shown, using liquid glue.
8. Cut a 3-1/2 x 4-3/4 inch piece of white cardstock and adhere it to the inside of the card as shown.
