

# 14 Card Double One Sheet Wonder



This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies. The supplies used to create these cards are available, while supplies last, through my Stampin' Up! store at <https://lynndunn.stampinup.net> so feel free to shop online for supplies or use some of your own materials that you may have on hand.

### One Sheet Wonder Cutting Template



1. Choose 2 coordinating pieces of patterned paper measuring 12 x 12 inch in size.
2. Place both pieces of patterned paper in your paper trimmer and use the template to cut both pieces at the same time.
3. Start by cutting the 12 x 12 papers into 4 inch strips. You will end up with 3 pieces measuring 4 x 12 inches.
4. Take each 4 x 12 inch set of papers and cut them to create two 5-1/4 inch pieces: one from the top and one from the bottom. You will be left with a 4 x 1-1/2 inch piece.

Now you are ready to create the 3 different designs.

This template can be used to create cards in portrait or landscape style.



## Card Design #1



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Old Olive cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.

2. Take the 4 corner pieces of patterned paper, from the template, which measure 4 x 5-1/4 inches. Cut each of these pieces in half diagonally from corner to corner.

Note: If you are using the Painterly Pears DSP, be sure to cut it diagonally from the corners that will give you the most pear "pattern" on each diagonal piece.

3. Once you make the diagonal cut across the 4 x 5-1/4 inch pieces, you will end up with 4 diagonal pieces: 2 of the pear pattern and 2 of the green pattern. Shuffle the pieces around so you have a green and pear pattern together.

4. Adhere the green and pear patterned paper pieces, side by side, to the Old Olive card front to create the diagonal design.

5. Repeat this diagonal cutting process with the other three corner pieces (from the template) which measure 4 x 5-1/4 inches. Once you cut all four corner pieces diagonally, you will have enough pieces to create 8 cards.

### Decorating the Cards

6. Stamp a greeting on a scrap piece of white cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Cut out the greeting with the label die from the Perfectly Pears die set.



7. Cut out a set of pink flowers from one of the Painterly Pears DSP sheets using the Perfectly Pears dies.

8. Cut out the mesh style element from a piece of Petal Pink cardstock using the Perfectly Pears dies.

9. Adhere the mesh, greeting and flowers together as shown and then adhere to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.

10. Embellish with a Charming Shimmer Faceted Dots.

## Card Design #2



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Old Olive cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
2. Take the remaining two pieces of patterned paper, from the middle of the template, which measure 4 x 5-1/4 inches.
  - Cut the two pear design pieces of paper in half at 2 inches. (You will end up with 4 of these).
  - Cut the two green pieces of paper into 1 x 5-1/4 inch strips. (You will end up with 8 of these).
3. Adhere two of the green pieces and one of the pear pieces to the Old Olive card front as shown. Repeat this process with the remaining patterned paper pieces to create a total of 4 cards.

4. Take the 4 x 1-1/2 inch piece of white paper (from the center of the template) and cut it into 1 x 1-1/2 inch pieces. (Note: The back side of the white (pear) paper has this pink design.) Each piece will measure 1 x 1-1/2 inches. Snip the end into a banner and adhere to the card front of each of the 4 cards as shown.

### Decorating the Cards

5. Stamp a greeting on each of the 4 cards, as shown, using Early Espresso ink.
6. Cut out 3 small flowers from a piece of Petal Pink cardstock using the Perfectly Pears die set. Adhere a Charming Shimmer Faceted Dot in the center of each flower and then adhere to the card front as shown.
7. Embellish the banner with a Pressed Flower Motif.





### Card Design #3



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Old Olive cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
2. Take the remaining 5 pieces of patterned, from the template, which measure 4 x 1-1/2 inches.
3. Cut one of the green patterned papers in half to create two pieces measuring 3/4 x 4 inches.
4. Arrange the following pieces across the center of the card front (from left to right):
  - 3/4 x 4 inch piece of green patterned paper
  - 1-1/2 x 4 inch piece of the pear patterned paper
  - 1-1/2 x 4 inch piece of the green patterned paper

5. You will be able to create two cards with this design with the remaining pieces of patterned paper.

### Decorating the Cards

6. Stamp a greeting on a scrap piece of white cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Cut out the greeting with the label die from the Perfectly Pears die set.
7. Cut out a set of pears from one of the Painterly Pears DSP sheets using the Perfectly Pears dies.
8. Cut out the mesh style element from a piece of Darling Duckling cardstock using the Perfectly Pears dies.
9. Adhere the mesh, greeting and pears to the card front as shown.
10. Embellish with a few 2025-2027 In Color Pearls (Darling Duckling color).
