Coneflower Fun Fold Card Ideas





This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies. Card #1



- 1. Start with a $5-1/2 \times 8-1/2$ inch piece of Basic Gray cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 1 and 5-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
- 2. Cut a $5-1/2 \times 3/4$ inch piece of green patterned paper and adhere it to the top front flap of the fun fold card.
- 3. Cut a $3 \times 5-1/2$ inch piece of Country Woods DSP and emboss it with the Sunflower 3D Embossing Folder and adhere to the bottom front flap of the fun fold card.

Creating the Coneflower Fun Fold Section

4. Stamp the coneflower image on a 5-1/2 x 4-1/4 inch piece of Darling Duckling cardstock using Darling Duckling ink. Cut

out the coneflower image with the coordinating die. Note: The die will create two coneflowers with a score line in between. Fold on the score line.

- 5. Cut out the detailed coneflower shape from a piece of Darling Duckling cardstock. Use the dark shade of a Darling Duckling stampin' blend to highlight different parts of the coneflower petals. Use the light shade of a Pecan Pie stampin' blend to add additional highlights. Adhere this piece over the stamped coneflower using stampin' dimensionals. Cut out the top of the coneflower from a piece of Pecan Pie cardstock using the coordinating die. Adhere to the top of the flower with liquid glue.
- 6. Cut out another "double coneflower" shape from a piece of white cardstock. Trim off the top (upside down coneflower) as we will only use the bottom piece. Stamp a greeting on it using Basic Gray ink. Stamp the splatter image around the greeting using Darling Duckling ink. Adhere the white coneflower to the inside section of the yellow coneflower from step#5.

You are basically creating a coneflower tag. The front of the tag is the decorated coneflower (step#5), and the inside of the coneflower tag is where you place the greeting (step#6).

Middle Section of the Fun Fold Card

- 7. Open up the fun fold card. Cut a 4 x 5-1/2 inch piece of the Country Woods DSP and emboss it with the Sunflower 3D embossing folder. Lay this piece on the inside of the card and center it between the two score lines. Add liquid glue behind the 1" section of the front flap and fold the 1" flap down onto the embossed DSP. You are basically gluing the embossed DSP behind the 1" fun fold flap. This creates the middle section of the fun fold card.
- 8. Adhere the back of the folded coneflower tag to the top of the middle section of the card. Note: The coneflower tag will be adhered to the middle section of the card overlapping the green DSP and the embossed piece (from Step#4).



9. Close the front flap of the fun fold over the greeting and then close the top of the coneflower tag over the front flap of the fun card.



Front Coneflower

- 10. Stamp the coneflower image on a $5-1/2 \times 4-1/4$ inch piece of white cardstock using Basic Gray ink. Color in the image using the light and dark shades of the Darling Duckling stampin' blends. Color in the top of the coneflower using the Pecan Pie stampin' blend.
- 11. Cut out the coneflower image using the "double coneflower" tag shape. Fold on the score line and adhere the two coneflower pieces together with liquid glue.
- 12. Stamp the stem and leaf images on a scrap piece of white cardstock using Basic Gray ink. Color in the images using the Old Olive stampin' blends. Cut out the images with the

coordinating dies. Adhere the stem, leaves, and the bottom part of the coneflower (from Step#11) to the bottom part of the front flap of the fun fold card.

Note: This coneflower rests under the other coneflower which was adhered to the card in Step#8 and is revealed when you lift up the yellow coneflower tag.

13. Stamp a greeting, twice, on a 1/2 inch wide scrap piece of white cardstock using Basic Gray ink. Cut down the greetings with a scissors and adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.



Inside of the Fun Fold Card

- 14. Open up the fun fold card to reveal the three sections on the inside of the card.
- 15. Cut a 5-1/2 x 4 inch piece of white cardstock. Stamp the coneflower image using Darling Duckling ink. Stamp the sentiment using Basic Gray ink. Adhere the white cardstock to the inside of the fun fold card inbetween the two score lines.
- 16. Cut a $5-1/2 \times 3$ inch piece of green patterned paper and adhere it to the bottom section of the inside of the card as shown.

Portrait Style



You can create/decorate this card in portrait style. The measurements are exactly the same as the landscape style card described above.

The only difference between the two cards is that part of the inside of the coneflower tag (the part with the greeting) is adhered behind the 1" section of the front flap of the card along with the patterned paper.
