

Easy Triangle Fun Fold Design



This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies. Card #1 – Portrait Style



1. Start with a 4-1/4 x 11 inch piece of Pretty Peacock cardstock. Score the 11 inch side at 5-1/2 inches to create the base of the card.

2. Measure 4-1/4 inches up from the bottom of the card front and make a pencil mark on the left side of the card front.

Score the card front diagonally from the pencil mark to the opposite bottom corner of the card front. Fold on the score line and secure the triangular piece down to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.

3. Cut a 4 x 1 inch piece of patterned paper and adhere it to the top of the card front as shown.

4. Cut a 3-1/2 x 3-1/2 inch piece of Granny Apple Green cardstock. Adhere it to the triangular folded piece on the card front.

5. Cut a 2-3/4 x 2-3/4 inch piece of basic white cardstock (or use the Stylish Shapes dies to create this piece).

6. Stamp a greeting on the upper right side of the basic white cardstock using Pretty Peacock ink. Adhere the basic white square piece to the Granny Apple Green cardstock as shown.

7. Cut out a variety of images from a piece of the Turtle-y Cut DSP using a scissors. Adhere the images to the basic white square, as shown, using stampin' dimensionals.

8. Embellish the top of the card front with a few Pressed Flower Motifs.

Inside of the Card

9. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of white cardstock and adhere it to the inside of the card.

10. Cut a 4 x 4 inch piece of patterned paper. Cut this piece in half, diagonally, from corner to corner. Adhere one of the pieces to the lower right side of the basic white cardstock from Step#9.

Card #2 – Landscape Style



1. Start with a 4-1/4 x 11 inch piece of Pretty Peacock cardstock. Score the 11 inch side at 5-1/2 inches to create the base of the card.

2. Measure 4-1/4 inches from the right side of the card front and make a pencil mark on the bottom side of the card front.

Score the card front diagonally from the pencil mark to the opposite corner of the card front. Fold on the score line and secure the triangular piece down to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.

3. Cut a 1 x 4 inch piece of patterned paper and adhere it to the left side of the card front as shown.

4. Cut a 3-1/2 x 3-1/2 inch piece of Granny Apple Green cardstock. Adhere it to the triangular folded piece on the card front.

5. Cut a 2-3/4 x 2-3/4 inch piece of basic white cardstock (or use the Stylish Shapes dies to create this piece).

6. Stamp a greeting on the upper right side of the basic white cardstock using Pretty Peacock ink. Adhere the basic white square piece to the Granny Apple Green cardstock as shown.

7. Cut out a variety of images from a piece of the Turtle-y Cut DSP using a scissors. Adhere the images to the basic white square, as shown, using stampin' dimensionals.

8. Embellish the top of the card front with a few Pressed Flower Motifs.

Inside of the Card

9. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of white cardstock and adhere it to the inside of the card.

10. Cut a 4 x 4 inch piece of patterned paper. Cut this piece in half, diagonally, from corner to corner. Adhere one of the pieces to the lower right side of the basic white cardstock from Step#9.
