# 7 Autumn Cards One Sheet Wonder





This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.



# **One Sheet Wonder Cutting Template**

- 1. Choose one piece of double-sided patterned paper measuring 12 x 12 inch in size.
- 2. Start by cutting the 12 x 12 paper into 4 inch strips. You will end up with 3 pieces measuring 4 x 12 inches.
- 3. Take each of the 4" strips and cut the pieces according to the template.





- 1. Start with a  $5-1/2 \times 8-1/2$  inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
- 2. Use the three pieces from the One Sheet Wonder template labeled 1a, 1b and 1c. Adhere each piece, in order, down the card front as shown.

Note: One side of the patterned paper has a pumpkin pattern, and the other side has a subtle design.

- 3. Cut out the decorative label shape from a piece of very vanilla cardstock using one of the Traditional Labels dies.
- 4. Stamp a greeting on the decorative label shape using Early Espresso ink and adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.
- 5. For the finishing touch, embellish the card with a few streaked dots.

## Card #2



- 1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
- 2. Use the three pieces from the One Sheet Wonder template labeled 2a, 2b and 2c. Adhere each piece, in order, down the card front as shown.

Note: One side of the patterned paper has a pumpkin pattern, and the other side has a subtle design.

- 3. Cut out the decorative label shape from a piece of very vanilla cardstock using one of the Traditional Labels dies.
- 4. Stamp a greeting on the decorative label shape using Early Espresso ink and adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.
- 5. For the finishing touch, embellish the card with a few streaked dots.



- 1. Start with a  $5-1/2 \times 8-1/2$  inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
- 2. Adhere the piece labeled Card#3, from One Sheet Wonder template, to the card front as shown.
- 3. Cut a  $4 \times 1/2$  inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock and adhere it across the patterned paper as shown.
- 4. Cut out the decorative label shape from a piece of very vanilla cardstock using one of the Traditional Labels dies.
- 5. Stamp a greeting on the decorative label shape using Early Espresso ink and adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.
- 6. For the finishing touch, embellish the card with a few streaked dots.

#### Card #4



- 1. Start with a  $5-1/2 \times 8-1/2$  inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
- 2. Use the two pieces from the One Sheet Wonder template labeled 4a and 4b. Adhere 4a in the background. Adhere 4b over the top of 4a.

Note: One side of the patterned paper has a pumpkin pattern, and the other side has a subtle design.

- 3. Cut out the decorative label shape from a piece of very vanilla cardstock using one of the Traditional Labels dies.
- 4. Stamp a greeting on the decorative label shape using Early Espresso ink and adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.
- 5. For the finishing touch, embellish the card with a few streaked dots.



- 1. Start with a  $5-1/2 \times 8-1/2$  inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
- 2. Use the two pieces from the One Sheet Wonder template labeled Card #5. Adhere each piece, side by side, on the card front as shown.

Note: One side of the patterned paper has a pumpkin pattern, and the other side has a subtle design.

- 3. Cut out the decorative label shape from a piece of very vanilla cardstock using one of the Traditional Labels dies.
- 4. Stamp a greeting on the decorative label shape using Early Espresso ink and adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.
- 5. For the finishing touch, embellish the card with a few streaked dots.

## Card #6



- 1. Start with a  $5-1/2 \times 8-1/2$  inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
- 2. Cut a  $5-1/4 \times 4$  inch piece of Very Vanilla cardstock. Emboss it with the Gathering Leaves embossing folder and adhere to the card front.
- 3. Adhere the piece from the One Sheet Wonder template labeled 6a across the top of the embossed vanilla cardstock.
- 4. Cut a 4-1/4 x 3 inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Adhere the piece from the One Sheet Wonder template labeled 6b to the Early Espresso cardstock and then adhere to the center of the card front with stampin' dimensionals.
- 5. Cut out the decorative label shape from a piece of very vanilla cardstock using one of the Traditional Labels dies.
- 6. Stamp a greeting on the decorative label shape using Early Espresso ink and adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.
- 7. For the finishing touch, embellish the card with a few streaked dots.



- 1. Start with a  $5-1/2 \times 8-1/2$  inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
- 2. Cut a  $5-1/4 \times 4$  inch piece of Very Vanilla cardstock. Emboss it with the Gathering Leaves embossing folder and adhere to the card front.
- 3. Adhere the three pieces from the One Sheet Wonder template labeled Card#7 across the center of the embossed vanilla cardstock as shown.
- 4. Cut out the decorative label shape from a piece of very vanilla cardstock using one of the Traditional Labels dies.
- 5. Stamp a greeting on the decorative label shape using Early Espresso ink and adhere to the card front, as shown,

with stampin' dimensionals.

6. For the finishing touch, embellish the card with a few streaked dots.
