Faux Step Cards





This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.

Card #1



- 1. Start with a $4-1/4 \times 9$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 9 inch side at 1-1/4, 2-1/2, and 5-3/4 inches. Accordion fold on all the score lines to create the base of the step card.
- 2. Cut a $4-1/8 \times 3-1/8$ inch piece of patterned paper and adhere it to section in between the 2-1/2 and 5-3/4 inch score line.
- 3. Cut a $2-1/2 \times 9$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 9 inch side at 4-1/2 inches. Fold in half. Adhere one half of this piece to the middle of the 1-1/4" section on the front of the step card.

Fold the card flat and adhere the other half to the back of the

step card base. Be sure to watch the video to see the assembly process in action.

Decorating the Front of the Step Card

- 4. Cut a $2-3/8 \times 3-3/4$ inch piece of the striped patterned paper and adhere it to the top part of the front panel of the card.
- 5. Cut a 4-1/8 x 1-1/8 inch piece of the tree patterned paper and adhere it across the bottom of the front of the step card so it overlaps the piece from Step#4.
- 6. Stamp the acorn and leaf image on a scrap piece of Very Vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Cut out the image with the coordinating Amber Autumn die.
- 7. Stamp a greeting on a scrap piece of Very Vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut the image using one of the Textured Notes dies.



8. Adhere the greeting to the acorn/leaf image as shown. Add a bit of linen thread behind the images and then adhere to the center of the step card with stampin' dimensionals.

Inside of the Fun Fold Card



- 9. Open up the fun fold card. Add the following pieces from top to bottom on the inside of the card as shown:
- 4-1/8 x 1-1/8 inch tree patterned paper
- 4-1/8 x 3-1/8 inch striped patterned paper
- 4-1/8 x 3-1/8 inch very vanilla cardstock
- 10. Close the fun fold card and flip it over to the back.

Cut a 4-1/8 x 3-1/8 inch piece of the tree patterned paper and adhere it to the back side of the fun fold card.

Card #2



- 1. Start with a $4-1/4 \times 9$ inch piece of Cajun Craze cardstock. Score the 9 inch side at 1-1/4, 2-1/2, and 5-3/4 inches. Accordion fold on all the score lines to create the base of the step card.
- 2. Cut a $4-1/8 \times 3-1/8$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Cut a 4×3 inch piece of the pumpkin patterned paper. Adhere the two pieces together and then adhere it to section in between the 2-1/2 and 5-3/4 inch score line.
- 3. Cut a $2-1/2 \times 9$ inch piece of Cajun Craze cardstock. Score the 9 inch side at 4-1/2 inches. Fold in half. Adhere one half of this piece to the middle of the 1-1/4" section on the front of the step card.

Fold the card flat and adhere the other half to the back of the step card base. Be sure to watch the video to see the assembly process in action.

Decorating the Front of the Step Card

- 4. Cut a $2-3/8 \times 3-3/4$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Cut a $2-1/4 \times 3-5/8$ inch piece of the gray colored patterned paper. Adhere these two pieces together and then adhere it to the top part of the front panel of the card.
- 5. Cut a $4-1/8 \times 1-1/8$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Cut a 4×3 inch piece of the pumpkin patterned paper. Adhere these two pieces together and then adhere it across the bottom of the front of the step card, so it overlaps the piece from Step#4.
- 6. Stamp the pumpkin image on a scrap piece of Very Vanilla cardstock using Cajun Craze ink. Cut out the image with the coordinating Amber Autumn die.



- 7. Stamp a greeting on a scrap piece of Very Vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Die cut the image using one of the Textured Notes dies.
- 8. Adhere the greeting to the pumpkin image as shown and then adhere to the center of the step card with stampin' dimensionals.
- 9. Cut a $4-1/8 \times 3-1/8$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Cut a 4×3 inch piece of the pumpkin patterned paper. Adhere the two pieces together and then adhere it to the back of the step card.

Decorate the inside of the card as desired.
