

Fun Fold with Surprise Inside



This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.

Fun Fold Card Base

1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 11 inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 11 inch side at 1-1/4, 4-1/4, 5-1/2, and 6-3/4 inches. Accordion fold on all the score lines to create the base of the card.



2. Open the fun fold card base and lay it flat in front of you. Adhere the following pieces, from left to right, in each section of the fun fold card:

- Cut a 1 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the striped patterned paper and adhere it to the first section of the fun fold card.
- Cut a 2-3/4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the tree patterned paper and adhere it to the second section of the fun fold card.
- Cut a 1 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the arrow style patterned paper and adhere it to the third section of the fun fold card.
- Cut a 1 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the striped patterned paper and adhere it to the fourth section of the fun fold card.
- Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of Very Vanilla cardstock and adhere it to the last section of the fun fold card.

3. Cut a 1-1/4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the arrow style patterned paper and adhere it to the right side of the Very Vanilla cardstock.

4. Stamp a message on the Very Vanilla cardstock (to the left of the patterned paper from Step#3) using Early Espresso ink.

Once you have added all the patterned paper pieces, you are ready to create the front focal point and pop up surprise for the inside of the card.

Front Focal Point



5. Cut a 2-1/4 x 3-3/4 inch piece of Very Vanilla cardstock or using the Textured Notes dies to create this piece.

6. Stamp a greeting on the top of the vanilla rectangular shape using Early Espresso ink. Stamp the checkered style image on the bottom of this shape using Early Espresso ink.

7. Stamp the outline of the squirrel image on a scrap piece of vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Stamp the coordinating solid image of the squirrel, inside the outline image, using Pecan Pie ink. Cut out the squirrel image with the coordinating punch and adhere to the center of the vanilla rectangular shape as shown.

8. Stamp the acorn image 5 times on a scrap piece of vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Color in the acorns using stampin' blends. Cut out the acorns with the coordinating punch. Adhere 3 of the acorns to the vanilla rectangular piece as shown.

9. Adhere the rectangular shape to the front flap of the fun fold card as shown.

10. Cut a 2-3/4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the tree patterned paper and adhere it behind the front flap of the fun fold card as shown.

Inside Pop Up Surprise

11. Cut a 1-3/4 x 3-1/4 inch piece of Verry Vanilla cardstock or use the Textured Notes dies to create this piece.

12. Stamp the checkered style image on the bottom of the vanilla rectangular shape using Early Espresso ink.

13. Stamp the outline of the other squirrel image on a scrap piece of vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Stamp the coordinating solid image of the squirrel, inside the outline image, using Pecan Pie ink. Cut out the squirrel image with a scissors and adhere to the center of the vanilla rectangular shape as shown.

14. Adhere two acorns to the squirrel and rectangular shape for the inside of the card.

15. Adhere the left side of the rectangular shape (created in Step#11) to the inside of the card as shown.
