Card Ideas

Card #1



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Thick Basic White cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.

2. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of white cardstock.

3. Cut out the long slanted line rub-on design from the sheet, peel away the backing and place the metallic design on the left side of the white cardstock from Step#2.

Use a bone folder or your finger to transfer the design to the cardstock. Trim away any excess metallic pieces which overhang the edge of the cardstock. Adhere the white cardstock to the card front.

4. Cut a 3 x 5-1/4 inch piece of patterned paper and adhere it to the right of the metallic rub on design.

5. Cut a 1/4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock and adhere it to the right side of the card front as shown.
6. Cut the decorative label shape from a piece of white cardstock using the Traditional Labels dies. Adhere to the center of the green patterned paper.
7. Cut out one of the flower bouquets from a piece of the Traditions of Christmas patterned paper using the Christmas Greenery dies (or a scissors). Adhere to the center of the white label shape with stampin' dimensionals.
8. Cut a 3 x 1/2 inch piece of white cardstock. Stamp a greeting on it using Old Olive ink. Adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.

Card #2



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Old Olive cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
 2. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of white cardstock.
 3. Cut out the long swoosh rub-on design from the sheet, peel away the backing and place the metallic design on the right side of the white cardstock from Step#2.
- Use a bone folder or your finger to transfer the design to the cardstock. Adhere the white cardstock to the card front.
4. Cut a 2-1/4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of patterned paper.

5. Cut a 2-1/2 x 3 inch piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock. Adhere this piece behind the center of the patterned paper from Step#4 and then adhere to the left side of the card front as shown.
6. Cut out one of the flower bouquets from a piece of the Traditions of Christmas patterned paper using the Christmas Greenery dies (or a scissors). Adhere to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.
7. Cut a 3 x 1/2 inch piece of white cardstock. Stamp a greeting on it using Old Olive ink. Adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.

Card #3

1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Old Olive cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
2. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock.



3. Cut a 3-3/4 x 5 inch piece of white cardstock. Adhere this piece to the Cherry Cobbler piece from Step#2 and then adhere to the card front.
4. Stamp a greeting on the bottom of the white cardstock using Old Olive ink.
5. Cut a 3-3/4 x 1-1/2 inch piece of patterned paper and adhere it to the white cardstock above the greeting.
6. Cut out the small splatter rub-on design from the sheet and cut it into two pieces. Peel away the backing and place the metallic design on the top left and top right side of the white cardstock as shown. Use a bone folder or your finger to transfer the design to the cardstock.

7. Cut out one of the flower bouquets from a piece of the Traditions of Christmas patterned paper using the Christmas Greenery dies (or a scissors). Adhere to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.
8. Embellish the card with a few Traditional Sparkling Sequins.

Card #4



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Thick Basic White cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inches to create the base of the card.
2. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of white cardstock and emboss it with the Wreath 3D embossing folder. Adhere to the card front.
3. Cut out the rub-on design with dots from the sheet, peel away the backing and place the metallic design in the center of the white cardstock from Step#2.

Use a bone folder or your finger to transfer the design to the cardstock. Adhere the white cardstock to the card front.

4. Cut a 1 x 5-1/4 inch piece of patterned paper and adhere it to the bottom of the white cardstock.
5. Cut a 4 x 1/2 inch piece of white cardstock. Stamp a greeting on it using Old Olive ink. Adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.
6. Cut out one of the flower bouquets from a piece of the Traditions of Christmas patterned paper using the Christmas Greenery dies (or a scissors). Adhere to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.
7. Embellish the card with a few Traditional Sparkling Sequins.
