Double Z Gatefold Card





This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.

Card #1 - Double Z Gatefold Card



- 1. Start with a $5-1/2 \times 11$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 11 inch side at 1-1/4, 3-3/8, 7-5/8, and 9-3/4 inches. Fold on all the score lines to create the base of the card.
- 2. Cut two pieces of the green patterned paper at $1 \times 5-1/4$ inches. Adhere one to each of the two 1-1/4" flaps on the front of the card base.
- 3. Cut two pieces of the leaf patterned paper at $1-7/8 \times 5-1/4$ inches. Adhere one to each side of the front of the card, under the flaps from Step#2.
- 4. Cut a $2-3/8 \times 2-3/8$ inch piece of white cardstock (or use the Stylish Shapes Dies to create this piece.

- 5. Cut a $2-5/8 \times 2-5/8$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Adhere this piece behind the white cardstock from Step#4. Adhere in a diamond shape to the left front flap of the card front.
- 6. Stamp a three different leaf images using Cajun Craze, Crushed Curry and Old Olive ink on a scrap piece of white cardstock. Cut out the images with the coordinating dies.
- 7. Stamp the acorn image, twice, on a scrap piece of white cardstock using Pecan Pie ink. Cut out the images with the coordinating die.
- 8. Stamp a greeting on a scrap piece of white cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Cut out the greeting using one of the Stylish Shapes dies.
- 9. Arrange all the stamped images, from Step #6-8, on the white diamond shape. Tie two pieces of linen thread together into a bow. Adhere all the stamped images with dimensionals. Adhere the linen thread bow with a glue dot. Embellish as desired.

Decorating the Inside of the Card

- 10. Open the fun fold card base and lay it flat in front of you. Adhere the following pieces, from left to right, in each section of the inside of the fun fold card:
 - Cut a 1-7/8 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the leaf patterned paper and adhere it to the left section of the fun fold card (next to the green striped paper).
 - Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of white cardstock. Stamp a few images on the bottom of this piece and adhere it to the center of the inside of the card.
 - Cut a 1-7/8 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the leaf patterned paper and adhere it to the section to the right of the white cardstock.



Card #2 - Double Z Gatefold Card with Belly Band



- 1. Start with a $5-1/2 \times 11$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 11 inch side at 1-1/4, 3-3/8, 7-5/8, and 9-3/4 inches. Fold on all the score lines to create the base of the card.
- 2. Cut two pieces of the beige patterned paper at $1 \times 5-1/4$ inches. Adhere one to each of the two 1-1/4" flaps on the front of the card base.
- 3. Cut two pieces of the leaf patterned paper at $1-7/8 \times 5-1/4$ inches. Adhere one to each side of the front of the card, under the flaps from Step#2.

Creating the Belly Band

- 4. Cut a $1-1/2 \times 11$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Lay the card base, created in Step#1, in the center of this piece of cardstock. Loosely fold each side of the $1-1/2 \times 1$ inch piece of cardstock around the card base. Adhere the two ends of this piece together to create the belly band.
- 5. Cut two pieces of the Cajun colored patterned paper at $1-1/4 \times 4-1/4$ inches. Adhere one to the front and one to the back of the belly band.
- 6. Leave the belly band on the card based and create the focal point.

Creating the Focal Point

- 7. Cut a 2-3/8 x 2-3/8 inch piece of white cardstock (or use the Stylish Shapes Dies to create this piece.
- 8. Cut a $2-5/8 \times 2-5/8$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Adhere this piece behind the white cardstock from Step#4. Adhere in a diamond shape to the center of the belly band on the front of the card using stampin' dimensionals.
- 9. Stamp a three different leaf images using Cajun Craze, Early Espresso, and Basic Beige ink on a scrap piece of white cardstock. Cut out the images with the coordinating dies.
- 10. Stamp the acorn image on a scrap piece of white cardstock using Pecan Pie ink. Cut out the image with the coordinating die.
- 11. Stamp a greeting on a scrap piece of Basic Beige cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Cut out the greeting using one of the Stylish Shapes dies.
- 12. Arrange all the stamped images, from Step #9-11, on the white diamond shape. Adhere all the stamped images with dimensionals. Embellish as desired.

Decorating the Inside of the Card

- 13. Remove the belly band and open the fun fold card base. Lay it flat in front of you. Adhere the following pieces, from left to right, in each section of the inside of the fun fold card:
 - Cut a 1-7/8 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the leaf patterned paper and adhere it to the left section of the fun fold card (next to the beige paper).
 - Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of white cardstock. Stamp a few images on this piece and adhere it to the center of the inside of the card.
 - Cut a 1-7/8 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the leaf patterned paper and adhere it to the section to the right of the white cardstock.
