Panel Style Gatefold Card





This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.

Card Base

- 1. Cut a $4-1/4 \times 5-1/2$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock for the base of the card.
- 2. Cut two pieces of the striped patterned paper at $1 \times 5-1/4$ inches. Adhere one to each side of the card base.

Gatefold Section

- 3. Start with a $5-1/2 \times 8$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Score the 8 inch side at 1-1/2, 2-3/4, 5-1/4, and 6-1/2 inches. Fold on all the score lines to create the gatefold section of the card.
- 4. Adhere the center of the gatefold section to the center of the

Front Panel of the Card

5. Cut a $3-1/2 \times 5-1/2$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Fold down the front flaps of the gate fold section and hold them down to keep them closed.

Add glue to the left front flap of the gatefold section. Position the $3-1/2 \times 5-1/2$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock in the center of the gatefold section and press down to adhere the flap. The front panel should be centered on the card (when the card is closed) and it should only be adhered to the left front flap of the gatefold section. I recommend watching the video to see this process in action.



- 6. Cut a $3-1/4 \times 5-1/4$ inch piece of patterned paper and adhere it to the front panel of the card.
- 7. Cut a $3-1/4 \times 1$ inch piece of Very Vanilla cardstock. Emboss it with the Gathering Leaves embossing folder and adhere it to the bottom of the patterned paper from Step#6.
- 8. Cut a $3-1/4 \times 2$ inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Cut the deer images into the cardstock using the Autumn Trees dies. Adhere it across the top of the vanilla cardstock on the front panel of the card.
- 9. Stamp a greeting on a scrap piece of Very Vanilla cardstock using Early Espresso ink. Cut out the greeting using one of the Stylish Shapes dies. Add a $2 \times 3/4$ inch piece of Early Espresso

cardstock behind the greeting and then adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.

Decorating the Inside of the Gatefold Section of the Card

- 10. Open up the gatefold section of the card and fold the front panel behind the card. Adhere the following pieces, from left to right, across the inside of the gatefold card:
 - Cut a 1-1/2 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the tree patterned paper and adhere it to the left side of the inside of the card (note this is the back side of the front panel).
 - Cut a 1 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the striped patterned paper and adhere it to the section next to the tree patterned paper.
 - Cut a 2-14 x 5-1/4 inch piece of Very Vanilla cardstock and adhere it to the middle section of the inside of the card.
 - Cut a 1 x 5-1/4 inch piece of the striped patterned paper and adhere it to the section to the right of the vanilla cardstock.

- Cut a $1-1/4 \times 5-1/4$ inch piece of Very Vanilla cardstock. Emboss it with the Gathering Leaves embossing folder and adhere it to the last section on the right side of the inside of the card.
- 11. Cut a 2-1/4 x 2 inch piece of Early Espresso cardstock. Cut the deer images into the cardstock using the Autumn Trees dies. Adhere to the bottom of the vanilla cardstock on the inside of the card.
