

# Inside Pop Up Christmas Card



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This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.

### Card Front



1. Start with a 4-1/4 x 11 inch piece of Thick Basic White cardstock. Score the 11 inch side at 5-1/2 inches to create the base of the card.

2. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of white cardstock and emboss it with the Traditional Wreath 3D embossing folder. Adhere to the card front.

3. Cut a 4 x 1/2 inch piece of the red patterned paper and adhere to the card front as shown.

4. Cut a 4 x 2-3/4 inch piece of the green patterned paper and adhere to the card front as shown.

5. Cut a 3-1/4 x 1/2 inch piece of white cardstock. Stamp a greeting on it using Old Olive ink. Adhere to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.

6. Cut out one of the floral bouquets from a piece of the Traditional Christmas Designer Series Paper using the Christmas Greenery Dies (or a scissors). Adhere to the card front with stampin' dimensionals.

## Inside Pop Up Section

7. Cut a 3-3/4 x 10-1/2 inch piece of white cardstock. Score the 10-1/2 inch side at 5-1/4 inches. Do not fold on the score line.

8. Lay the white cardstock (from Step#7) on the platform of an embossing machine. Place one of the Pop Up Petal Dies directly in the center of the 5-1/4 inch score line. Line up the arrows on the die with the score line. Run the die through the embossing machine to create the pop up section.

9. The Pop Up Petals die will cut and score the center of the white cardstock. Fold the white cardstock in half and then pop out the center section (as pictured).

10. Place the top part of the white cardstock in the Traditional Wreath 3D embossing folder. Run it through an embossing machine to create the texture on the top of this cardstock piece.



11. Cut a 3-3/4 x 1/2 inch piece of the red patterned paper and adhere to the embossed white cardstock as shown.

12. Cut a 3-3/4 x 2-3/4 inch piece of the green patterned paper and adhere to the embossed white cardstock as shown.

13. Adhere the entire piece of white cardstock to the top and bottom of the inside of the card base (which was created in Step#1). Be sure to watch the video for some tips on adhering the pop section to the inside of the card.

### Creating the Pop Up Focal Point

14. Cut a 2-1/4 x 3-3/4 inch piece of white cardstock (or use the Textured Notes dies to create this piece).

15. Cut a 2-3/8 x 3-7/8 inch piece of Cherry Cobbler cardstock. Adhere this piece behind the white cardstock.

16. Cut out one of the floral bouquets from a piece of the Traditional Christmas Designer Series Paper using the Christmas Greenery Dies (or a scissors). Adhere to the white rectangular shape with stampin' dimensionals.

17. Add a bit of glue to the 1 inch pop up section on the inside of the card. Push the rectangular shape onto the glue and then fold the card front down to secure the pop up section.
