

# Double Heart Fun Fold Cards



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This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies.

### **Card #1**



1. Start with a 4-1/4 x 5-1/2 inch piece of Poppy Parade cardstock for the base of the card.
2. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of Basic White cardstock.
3. Cut two large heart shapes from a piece of the Made with Love Designer Series Paper.
4. Lay the heart shapes on the Basic White cardstock from Step #2 so they overlap each other (as shown). Use a pencil to mark the top and bottom of the side of each of the two heart shapes that overhangs the white cardstock.

Score from the top to the bottom pencil mark on each of the heart shapes. Be sure to watch the video to see this process in action [https://youtu.be/9KXG4GD2\\_X0](https://youtu.be/9KXG4GD2_X0)

5. Lay the scored side of one heart on the left side of the white cardstock and the scored side of the other heart on the right side of the Basic White cardstock. Adhere the excess part of each of the scored hearts to the back of the Basic White cardstock. Then adhere the entire piece of Basic White cardstock to the card front. The two overlapping hearts serve as the fun fold section for this card.

6. Stamp a greeting on a 1/2 inch wide piece of white cardstock using black ink. Dovetail the right side of the greeting. Adhere the greeting to the top heart using stampin' dimensionals.

7. Cut a heart shape from a piece of Basic White cardstock using the Endless Love dies. Emboss this heart shape with the Hearts of Love 3D embossing folder. Adhere this heart shape to the bottom heart shape, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.

8. Cut the small arrow shape from a piece of Basic Black cardstock using the Endless Love dies. Snip one of the arrows in half and adhere to the bottom heart of the fun fold card, as shown, with liquid glue.

9. Embellish the card front with a few envelope and pink heart shapes from the Loose Valentine's Assortment.

### Inside of the Card

10. Stamp the "LOVE" word in the center of the inside of the card using black ink.

### Card #2



1. Start with a 4-1/4 x 5-1/2 inch piece of Flirty Flamingo cardstock for the base of the card.

2. Cut a 4 x 5-1/4 inch piece of Basic White cardstock.

3. Cut two large heart shapes from a piece of the Made with Love Designer Series Paper.

4. Lay the heart shapes on the Basic White cardstock from Step #2 so they overlap each other (as shown). Use a pencil to mark the top and bottom of the side of each of the two heart shapes that overhangs the white cardstock.

5. Lay the scored side of one heart on the left side of the white cardstock and the scored side of the other heart on the right side of the Basic White cardstock. Adhere the excess part of each of the scored hearts to



the back of the Basic White cardstock. Then adhere the entire piece of Basic White cardstock to the card front. The two overlapping hearts serve as the fun fold section for this card.

6. Stamp a greeting on a 1/2 inch wide piece of white cardstock using black ink. Dovetail the right side of the greeting. Adhere the greeting to the top heart using stampin' dimensionals.

7. Cut a heart shape from a piece of Basic White cardstock using the Endless Love dies. Emboss this heart shape with the Hearts of Love 3D embossing folder. Adhere this heart shape to the bottom heart shape, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals.

8. Cut the fancy heart shape from a piece of Basic Black cardstock using the Endless Love dies. Adhere the fancy black heart shape to the embossed white heart shape with liquid glue.

9. Embellish the card front with a few envelope shapes from the Loose Valentine's Assortment.

### Inside of the Card

10. Stamp the "LOVE" word in the center of the inside of the card using black ink.
