

Split Negative Technique



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This tutorial contains all the measurements and instructions that you need to recreate these cards along with a complete list of supplies. Card #1



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Thick Basic White cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inch to create the base of the card. Create two card bases.
2. Cut a 4-1/4 x 5-1/2 inch piece of Basic White cardstock.
3. Adhere the Flower Fair image to the acrylic plate of a stamp positioner tool. Center the Basic White cardstock under the stamp so the image will cover the entire piece of cardstock. Use grid paper to mark off the left side and top of the cardstock. Refer to the video for guidance on placement.
4. Ink up the image with Night of Navy ink and stamp it on the white cardstock.
4. Remove the large acrylic plate from the stampin' positioner tool and clean the image. Do not remove the stamp.

5. Cut a 4-1/4 x 5-1/2 inch piece of Night of Navy cardstock. Align this cardstock piece in the exact same spot where you marked off the white cardstock. Ink up the stamp image with versamark, place the large acrylic plate back on the stamp positioner tool and stamp the image onto the Night of Navy cardstock.

Generously sprinkle white embossing powder across the versamrk stamped image, tap off the excess powder and heat to set the image.

6. Cut the stamped Basic White cardstock in half at 2-1/8 inches. You will end up with two pieces measuring 2-1/8 x 5-1/2 inches.

7. Cut the heat embossed Night of Navy cardstock in half at 2-1/8 inches. You will end up with two pieces measuring 2-1/8 x 5-1/2 inches

8. Take one 2-1/8 x 5-1/2 inch Basic White stamped cardstock piece and one 2-1/8 x 5-1/2" Night of Navy cardstock pieces and adhere them side by side to the front of a card base. The floral design on the pieces, when adhered together, will be consistent and match up perfectly. Refer to the video for tips on this process.

9. Take the remaining 2-1/8 x 5-1/2 inch pieces of the stamped white and Night of Navy cardstock and adhere them side by side to the front of a second card base.

10. Cut a 3/4 x 3 inch piece of white cardstock. Dovetail one end. Stamp a greeting on it and adhere it to the card front, as shown, with stampin' dimensionals. Repeat this process to create a greeting for the second card.

Card #2



1. Start with a 5-1/2 x 8-1/2 inch piece of Night of Navy cardstock. Score the 8-1/2 inch side at 4-1/4 inch to create the base of the card. Create two card bases.

2. Cut a 4 x 4 inch piece of Basic White cardstock.

3. Adhere the Flower Fair image to the acrylic plate of a stamp positioner tool. Center the Basic White cardstock under the top part of the stamp so the image will cover the entire piece of cardstock. Use grid paper to mark off the left side and top of the cardstock. Refer to the video for guidance on placement.

Ink up the image with Night of Navy ink and stamp it on the white cardstock.

4. Remove the large acrylic plate from the stampin' positioner tool and clean the image. Do not remove the stamp.



5. Cut a 4 x 4 inch piece of Night of Navy cardstock. Align this cardstock piece in the exact same spot where you marked off the white cardstock. Ink up the stamp image with versamark, place the large acrylic plate back on the stamp positioner tool and stamp the image onto the Night of Navy cardstock.

Generously sprinkle white embossing powder across the versamark stamped image, tap off the excess powder and heat to set the image.
6. Color the entire floral image on the 4 x 4 inch piece of white cardstock using stampin' blends.
7. Cut the stamped and colored 4 x 4 inch piece of Basic White cardstock at 2-1/4 inches. You will end up with two pieces: one measuring 2-1/4 x 4 and the other measuring 1-3/4 x 4 inches.
8. Cut the heat embossed 4 x 4 inch piece of Night of Navy cardstock 2-1/4 inches. You will end up with two pieces: one measuring 2-1/4 x 4 and the other measuring 1-3/4 x 4 inches.
9. Take the 2-1/4 x 4 inch piece of the Basic White stamped and colored cardstock piece and the 1-3/4 x 4 inch piece of the Night of Navy cardstock. Adhere these pieces side by side to the top front part of a Night of Navy card base.
10. Take the remaining pieces of the stamped and colored white cardstock and the Night of Navy cardstock and adhere them side by side to the top front part of another Night of Navy card base.
11. Cut two pieces of Balmy Blue cardstock at 4 x 1-1/4 inches. Adhere one the bottom of each of the card fronts as shown.
12. Cut two pieces of Basic White cardstock at 4 x 1 inches. Stamp a greeting on each piece using Night of Navy ink and adhere it across the center of the Balmy Blue cardstock on each of the card bases.
13. Embellish the greeting with a few Moody Palette Dots.
